## COVID-19 General Information

The safety of our drivers and passengers is our top priority. During the COVID-19 pandemic it is important to follow the advice of health authorities to stem the spread of the virus and keep everyone safe.

The Australian Medical Association has provided some [simple steps](#) to keep everyone safe:

- Wash your hands with soap and water often or use hand sanitiser
- Cover your mouth or nose when coughing or sneezing
- Avoid rubbing your eyes and touching your nose or face as this spreads germs
- Do not have close contact with people who are unwell

Drivers will conduct a thorough clean of their vehicles between each ride they complete. High standards of hygiene and vehicle cleanliness will be maintained at all times. If anyone is unwell, they need to stay home and get tested.

## Information for drivers

All drivers should have measures in place to reduce the risk of spreading COVID-19. These measures include:

- Staying at home and self-isolating if you are feeling unwell
- Conduct appropriate cleaning and hygiene practices for all services. For more information about cleaning responsibilities click [here](#)
- High touch surfaces in vehicles should be cleaned during and after each drive with recommended products
- Drivers should also wash their hands thoroughly with soap and water, or hand sanitiser with at least 60 per cent alcohol, regularly
- Passengers should sit in the back seat of the vehicle where appropriate
